

# Why us? Two degrees in 7 semesters

The dual study programme Bachelor of Nursing is accredited and has been established at EHB since 2004. Dedicated lecturers teach in a familial environment and provide individualised support.

Based on the Nursing Professions Reform Act (PfIB-RefG) and the Nursing Studies Strengthening Act, the programme leads to a Bachelor of Science degree and a professional qualification as a registered nurse. The theoretical courses take place at the EHB and the practical learning phases in facilities of selected cooperation partners.

# Who is our target group?

The degree programme is aimed at interested individuals who want to qualify for the broad field of nursing work within the scope of their first professional orientation. Lateral entry is also possible for carers with professional experience. Registered nurses have the opportunity to have their completed nursing training credited towards the Bachelor's degree programme at the EHB. The Bachelor of Nursing (B.Sc.) degree can be obtained within just 4 semesters by transferring existing competences.

# **Admission requirements**

General higher education entrance qualification, university of applied sciences entrance qualification or another higher education entrance qualification recognised by law as equivalent or two years of professional experience as a registered nurse for lateral entry.

### What's new?

## The different organisational form of teaching

The nursing degree program will be a generalist one, i.e. you will gain broad knowledge in the field of health care and nursing, geriatric nursing and health care as well as paediatric nursing.

### Study duration: 7 semesters, 210 ECTS

### 1st to 6th semester

- Theoretical and practical modules alternate
- Practical modules take place at acute and long-term care inpatient facilities as well as in outpatient care institutions
- Elective modules deepen personal preferences and strengths
- A practice module abroad is possible as well as the participation in international networks such as the European Network of Nursing in Higher Education or the Florence Network of Nursing and Midwifery
- Evidence-based nursing and nursing research from the very beginning, certificate acquisition (e.g. algesiology specialist assistant) is also possible

#### 7th semester

- Interdisciplinary elective module for in-depth study (science, counselling, pedagogy)
- Scientific treatment of a topic within the framework of the bachelor's thesis
- The Bachelor of Science degree is recognised internationally and qualifies you to work abroad as well

## How will nursing change in the future?

You will be challenged by the new distribution of tasks between the professional groups within the health care system, new collaborations and responsibilities within the framework of goal-oriented health care. With your competences, you will manage health and care processes after graduation:

- You design highly complex nursing processes that are made based on the basis of science-based decisions.
- Your in-depth knowledge of the fundamentals of nursing science and the social-institutional frameworks within nursing enables you to play a decisive role in developing nursing care.
- You develop research-based solutions to problems as well as new technologies and transfer these to your professional activities.
- Extended competences for the exercise of medical activities from 2025.
