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#### Social Work, B. A.

- Standard study period: 7 semesters (210 credits)
- Academic degree: Bachelor of Arts (B. A.)
- State recognition as a social worker or social pedagogue is granted on application by the Senate
- Study start: Summer and winter semester

Professional fields of activity: The degree program qualifies students for work in public or private institutions in youth and family welfare, adult education, health care and various other fields of social activity.

#### Protestant Religious Education & Diaconia, B. A.

- Standard study period: 7 semesters (210 credits)
- Academic degree: Bachelor of Arts (B. A.)
- Study start: Winter semester

Professional fields of activity: The Bachelor's program qualifies students for community education work with all age groups in church congregations. The Bachelor's degree also trains other educational staff. The major in Diaconia combines training in a state-recognised social profession with a qualification in theology.

### Childhood Education, B. A.

The studies take place at the EHB, the practical training at the facilities of selected cooperation partners.

### Midwifery, B. Sc.

Midwives care for, accompany, support and monitor women and their newborn children during pregnancy, birth, postpartum and the breastfeeding phase. The study program is carried out in cooperation with numerous practical facilities in clinical and out-of-hospital obstetrics. Theoretical and practical teaching/learning events take place at the EHB. Theoretical knowledge is put to use during practical sessions in the newly established SkillsLab (training space) at the EHB.
